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#### CFD-IC COMMON FACULTY DEVELOPMENT-INSTRUCTOR COURSE

OCT 16-27 JAN 22-FEB 2

This 2 week / 80-hour course prepares instructors to teach, train, and facilitate learning in an adult learning environment. Learners will be introduced to instructor roles and responsibilities, teaching and learning models, professional and ethical requirements, and classroom management techniques.

#### CFD-DC COMMON FACULTY DEVELOPMENT-DEVELOPER COURSE

#### **DEC 4-15**

This 2 week / 80-hour course is designed to provide Army training and curriculum developers with the skills necessary to produce instructional products for institutional and operational training and education settings; it introduces the ADDIE model and the Accountable Instructional System (AIS).

## COACHING WORKSHOP

### NOV 15-17

This course covers the fundamentals of workplace coaching. During this program, participants will define formal and informal coaching, identify how coaching differs from counseling, therapy, and other activities, explore a range of coaching models, and practice their skills at coaching employees.

NOV 6-7 JAN 8-9	<b>OBSERVATION COURSE</b> This 2 day / 8-hour course introduces the new Army Instructor Competencies and prepares participants to conduct instructor observations and provide feedback using the revised Instructor Observation Rubric (IOR).
NOV 28-30	IWC INSTUCTOR WRITER COURSE This 3 day course ensures that participants can success- fully revise a lesson plan. IWC was developed to provide an alternative to the Common Faculty Development Course and the Instructional Design Basic Course which are required for the Senior Army Instructor Badge.
2ND QTR	TEDMMC TRAINING AND EDUCATION MIDDLE MANAGER COURSE TEDMMC is a 5 day / 40-hour course designed for those in mid-level management positions responsible for managing training and education products such as les- son plans, training support packages, courses, blocks of instruction, and training plans.
OCT 23-27	STEMC SENIOR TRAINING AND EDUCATION MANAGER COURSE STEMC provides an overview of how HQ TRADOC sup- ports centers and schools in terms of mission and func- tion. The focus is on managing and integrating training development activities with capability, force, and mate- riel development. Management of integration and standardization systems are studied from the perspec- tive of senior training development managers.
