SUBJECT: Policy Letter #9, Privately Owned Firearms

1. References:

- a. Army Regulation 190-11, Physical Security of Arms, Ammunition, and Explosives, dated 17 January 2019.
 - b. Fort Bliss Regulation 27-5, Prohibited Conduct, dated 287 October 2016.
- 2. Purpose: To outline the Commandant's guidance in the disposition of Privately Owned Firearms.
- 3. All assigned/attached personnel possessing privately owned firearms and weapons will properly register and store them as outlined in Fort Bliss Regulation 27-5. All assigned/attached personnel who reside permanently or temporarily on Fort Bliss in family quarters, bachelor enlisted quarters (BEQ), or troop barracks will register all privately owned firearms with the Provost Marshall's Office within 72 hours after arrival at Fort Bliss or 72 hours after acquisition of the firearm(s). Assigned/attached personnel residing in the barracked or BEQ must store their privately owned firearms at the NCO Academy arms room even after registration is complete.
- 4. Fort Bliss Regulation 27-5 registration requirements apply to all assigned/attached NCO Academy personnel. It is a leadership responsibility to ensure all Soldiers are in compliance with this sensitive requirement.
